#### **Technical Data**

Blizzard is based on sodium hydroxide, a strongly caustic ingredient. It also contains a blend of water softening agents, corrosion inhibitors and soil dispersants.

Blizzard is non foaming. The normal use level is between 2.0 - 2.5q/l.
