## **Description and Use**

Lemonel is a clear yellow liquid with a fresh lemon fragrance. It is a concentrated disinfectant recommended for use in hospitals, nursing homes, hotels and motels. Use dilution is 1:160.

#### **Features and Benefits**

Lemonel is a highly concentrated disinfectant with a use dilution of 1:160 (1/8 cup in 5 litres water). This makes it a very economical product to use.

Lemonel has a fresh lemon fragrance giving effective deodorising whilst cleaning.

#### How to Use

Use at a dilution of 1:160 (1/8 cup in a half filled bucket) on any clean or lightly soiled surface. If soiling is heavy increase concentration or preclean before disinfecting.

Do not mix any soaps, detergents or other chemicals with Lemonel or deactivation may occur.

#### **Technical Data**

Lemonel is a neutral pH liquid containing biodegradable non-ionic detergents, a fresh lemon fragrance and 8.0% quaternary ammonium compound for disinfecting.
