Description and Use

Lifter is an economical machine dishwashing detergent containing chlorine for destaining.

Features and Benefits

Lifter contains water softening agents. These prevent scale formulation in soft to moderately hard water areas and reduce the need for descaling in very hard water.

Lifter contains a chlorine bleach. This assists with removal of tannin stains from tea and coffee and other bleachable stains.

How to Use

Lifter is automatically dispensed by an electronic feeder. Simply change the drum when empty.

Lifter contains chlorine. Always store in a cool area and use old stock first to ensure the product has maximum chlorine content.

Technical Details

Lifter is a caustic liquid containing water softening agents, corrosion inhibitors and chlorine for bleaching. It is used at 2.0 to 3.0 g/l.

Lifter contains no surfactants and is non foaming.

Safety

Wear gloves and safety goggles when changing drums.

Lifter must only be used for machine dishwashing dispensed through an electronic feeder.

Never add manually, or use for manual dishwashing.
