Description and Use

Pine Disinfectant is a commercial grade disinfectant for general cleaning, disinfection and deodorising.

Features and Benefits

Pine Disinfectant is an economy product ideal for use where staff may not measure out products accurately.

Pine Disinfectant contains pine oil, not a pine fragrance. This assists with cleaning and gives a long lasting residual odour.

Pine Disinfectant has a neutral pH and is safe to use on all washable surfaces.

How to Use

Use Pine Disinfectant at a dilution of 1:20 (1 cup per 5 litres of water). If soiling is heavy preclean first. Warm water improves the cleaning efficiency.

Pine Disinfectant can also be used in a trigger spray as a spray and wipe disinfectant cleaner. Add 50 - 100ml in a 500ml bottle, or 75 - 150ml in a 750ml bottle.

Do not mix with any soaps, detergents or other chemicals as deactivation may occur.

Technical Data

Pine Disinfectant is a neutral pH product containing biodegradable non ionic detergents for cleaning, pine oil and a quaternary ammonium compound for disinfection.
