Description and Use

Portasan is cleaner, deodoriser and sanitary fluid for use in portable toilet systems. It is a dark blue liquid with a powdery floral fragrance.

Features and Benefits

Portasan uses a quaternary ammonium compound to stop growth of odour causing bacteria. This is odourless, unlike formaldehyde which is used in some products which has a pungent toxic odour.

Portasan also contains non ionic detergents to assist with cleaning and a high quality long lasting fragrance to deodorise the area.

How to Use

Use Portasan at a rate of 10ml per litre of waste holding tank capacity. Follow manufacturers instructions on how to add the product to the system.

Do not mix Portasan with other products as deactivation of the active ingredient may occur.

If product is spilled, rinse immediately with plenty of water to stop any staining of the blue dye.

Technical Data

Portasan contains 9% quaternary ammonium compound as the active antimicrobial ingredient. It also contains biodegradable detergents and a water softening agent to clean the toilet.

Portasan has a pH of 9.3 in the neat form which is mildly alkaline.
