Description and Use

Saniclear is available in 1 litre pods that can be used in manual or auto dispensers, or in 500ml pump bottles that can be fitted into wall brackets or placed on work surfaces.

How to Use

Ensure hands are clean and dry before use. Apply enough Saniclear to thoroughly wet hands and rub in well over entire surface of hands until dry.

Saniclear is an aqueous gel containing 70% v/v ethanol. It contains macadamia oil to condition the skin.
