Description and Use

Sanifoam is an instant hand sanitiser for use without water. The main area of use is in food preparation areas, food retail establishments, meat works, boning rooms, catering companies etc.

Sanifoam can also be used in a special hands free dispenser in the foyer of companies to allow visitors to sanitise their hands before entering.

It is ideal for sanitising the hands after changing nappies in child care centres.

Sanifoam can also be used on commercial fishing boats.

In laundries use Sanifoam to disinfect the hands after handling soiled linen before clean linen is handled.

Features and Benefits

Sanifoam is a clear liquid containing ethanol. This has excellent sanitising properties and evaporates off when spread over the hands for quick drying without any towels.

Sanifoam contains glycerine to prevent the skin drying if used on a frequent basis.

Sanifoam foams up when dispensed allowing the foam to easily spread over the skin for fast action

How to Use

Dispense onto hand and spread the foam all over the hands. Wave hands to reduce drying time if required.

Technical Data

Sanifoam is an aqueous liquid containing 40%v/v ethanol plus an antimicrobial ingredient. It contains emollients to condition the skin.

Sanifoam has a pH about 5.5 in the neat form.
