Description and Use

Prewash Spray is a fast acting spray to help remove oil, grease, cosmetics and other stains in convenient non aerosol form. Mild orange perfume.

Features and Benefits

Prewash Spray is a concentrated blend of biodegradable detergents and solvents for rapid penetration of oily and greasy stains. It effectively removes the stains without the need for rubbing or scrubbing.

Being a bulk liquid Prewash Spray is much more economical to use than aerosol products. It is also better for the environment with no hydrocarbon propellant entering the atmosphere.

How to Use

Decant neat into a trigger spray, then spray over affected area. Leave for 1 to 2 minutes to act before washing. If stain is a difficult one such as inks, leave for 10 minutes before washing.

Use Prewash Spray in a well ventilated area. Do not spray over paintwork or use near naked flames.

Prewash Spray is recommended to clean cuffs and collars, lipstick, cosmetics and other oily and greasy deposits.

For bleachable stains such as tea, coffee or wine, a bleach product such as Dominish is recommended.

Blood is best removed by soaking in cold water with an enzymatic detergent such as Domzyme.

Always try and identify the stain and use the appropriate product. There is no one product that will remove all stain types.

Technical Details

Prewash Spray is a blend of biodegradable non-ionic detergents, glycol ether solvents and an orange oil based solvent. It is neutral with a pH of 7.

Safety

Avoid contact with skin and eyes. If treating a lot of garments, or if skin is sensitive, wear rubber gloves.

Adjust trigger spray to give a coarse spray rather than a mist, so product goes onto the fabric not into the air.

Always use in a well ventilated area.
